Introduction

The District Institute of Education and Training (DIET) was envisioned in the National Policy of Education, 1986 and created by the Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development in the early 1990s to strengthen elementary education and support the decentralization of education to the District level.

Elementary Teacher Education in Manipur started with the establishment of first BTI at Imphal on 22nd August, 1955, then at Canchipur & Kakching in 1961. After about ten years of establishment of BTI at Imphal, BTC was then established in December 1965 at Imphal. Later, BTI and BTC, Imphal were merged and upgraded to District Institute of Education and Training (DIET), Imphal as per recommendation of NPE 1986, after the establishment of State Council of Educational Research and Training (SCERT) Manipur in 1989. The SCERT, Manipur came in existence by upgrading the erstwhile State Institute of Education (SIE).

At present there are nine DIETs in the State viz. DIET Imphal West (established in 1991), DIET Churachandpur (established in 1992), DIET Kakching (established in 1992), DIET Moirang (established in 1997), Senapati (established in 1997), DIET Chandel, DIET Tamei and DIET Ukhrul were established in 2002. The 9th DIETcenter - Imphal East started functioning from the session 2017-2018 at Keikol, Koirengei, Imphal East.

The DISTRICT INSTITUTE OF EDUCATION AND TRAINING (DIET), MOIRANG (Manipur) is a single Teacher's Training Institute of Bishnupur district and was established in 1997 at Moirang Lamkhai by the SCERT, Government of Manipur to cater the academic needs of the district. The center is situated between 24^o29"56.28"N latitude and 93^o45"47.37"E longitude, 43 kms away from the capital city Imphal along the Tiddim Road.

Objectives:

- To conduct pre-service teacher education programme.
- To conduct needs based In-service teacher education programme.
- To organize district level and state level education researches on issues pertaining to school education.
- To facilitate collaborative action researches to enable practicing teachers to address classroom issues.
- To involve in conducting innovative practices to encounter the changing needs in school education.
- To conduct periodical workshops, seminars, forums, for school teachers to disseminate updated information.
- To provide academic resource support to NFE functionaries and Anganwadis.
- To provide academic and resource support at the grassroots level for the success of various strategies and programmes being undertaken in the areas of Elementary Education with special reference to achieve the objectives of UEE.
- To acquaint the trainees with the educational imperatives in the purview of Right to Education Act, 2009, National Curriculum framework and National and State Level interventions in education taking place from time to time.
- To promote educational research and training to teachers and other personnel.
- To prescribed curricula and text book for the school teacher training institutes.
- To promote institutional materials for the use of teacher educators.

ROLE OF DIET, IN PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT OF SCHOOL TEACHERS.

- To provide leadership in innovating pre-service school teacher training.
- To contribute to development of quality learning materials for school education.
To carry out field base studies to improve the primary schools of our district.
- To provide support to district authorities in implementing quality school education.
- DIET Moirang doesn't limit itself to teacher training but also to manage quality aspects in schools, professional development of teachers, academic assessment monitoring, research and action research, ICT interventions and innovative practices.

Admission Policy:

- i) Name of Course : Two Years Pre-Service Course in Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed.)
- ii) No. of seat capacity : 50 (fifty) as approved by NCTE
- iii) Selection Procedure : The Entrance Test for All DIETs in Manipur shall be conducted on the same day as fixed by the SCERT, Govt. of Manipur. Selection of the trainees will be made strictly as per the order of merit in the entrance test followed by counselling.
- iv) Eligibility Criteria : To be eligible for admission to the First Year of the course the students shall have passed 10 +2 / XII with at least
 - * 50% marks in aggregate for general candidate.
 - * 45% marks for SC/ST/OBC and PWD Candidates (As per NCTE Norms).

Reservation: The reservation norms should be as per Govt. of Manipur.

- UR - 50 %
- ST - 31 %
- SC - 2 %
- OBC - 17 %
- PWD - Due consideration would be given.
